What if I'm not Catholic?

Several of our families are not Catholic. They do, however, have a strong sense of Christian values and want their children to be “submerged”, as it were, in those values all day long. St. Boniface is open to discussing its religious curriculum with parents so they understand what their children will be taught. We believe parents are the primary teachers of their children and we're there to aide you in teaching Christianity to your children.

How can I afford tuition?

Enrolling your child as a student in St. Boniface is an investment in their future. We have financial aid and loan programs available to fit every income and credit level.

I want my child to have an academic advantage ...

Catholic Schools have some of the highest success rates in education today. Our children test 21% higher on Terra Nova than the national average. Because our class sizes are small, we can offer more in the way of one to one help and we can offer more extra curricular activities. Read what our teachers have to say about St. Boniface.

There are less children in this school. I'm worried about my child's social integration.

At St. Boniface, we teach your child to appreciate their fellow students for the qualities they possess. Listen to the kids. They like our school because they can be friends with all the students, not just the ones in their grade. Your child will have the opportunity to join many groups to meet the kids they will mainstream with in junior high. (ie: Scouts, 4H, sports, band, etc.)

Will my child be able to participate in BCS sports and extra curricular activities?

Every activity that is available to the BCS system is offered through St. Boniface. Announcements and permission slips come to you in a weekly school communication envelope.

I work full time. What services are available for after school care?

St. Boniface offers an adult supervised after care program. Your child will have snack, playtime and homework time and assistance. You may pick your child up anytime after school until 6pm.

Can our child ride the bus to school?

Yes! Our bussing is provided by the BCS, Woodmore and Genoa school systems. If you do not currently live in those areas, we can look into getting bussing to your child.
